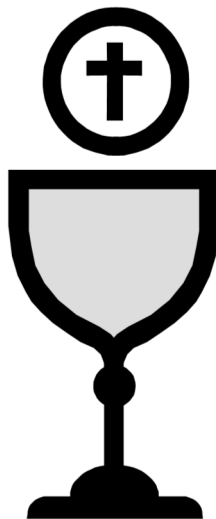

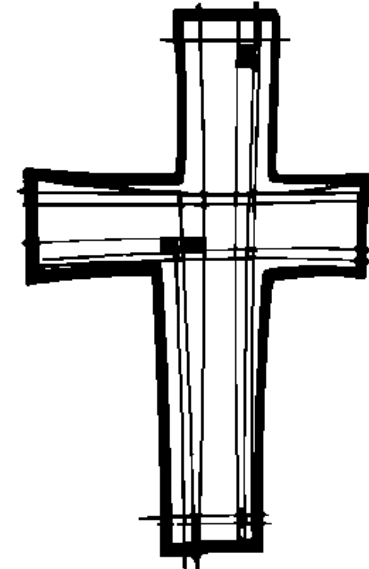

Customary Preparation Ages

At Our Lady of Light Parish and throughout the Diocese of Venice, the customary grade for beginning preparations for First Reconciliation and First Communion is the second grade or older. The process of preparation for Confirmation begins in grades nine or older.

Expectations

- **Weekly Mass Attendance**

The celebration of the Eucharistic Liturgy (Mass) is the central point around which parish life and Faith Formation flow. **Weekly participation in the Mass is an expectation** of all children preparing to celebrate the sacraments. If you are not regularly participating in weekly Mass, please contact the office prior to registering.

We also invite and encourage your family to **be an active part** of the Mass celebration. Consider signing up your family members to serve in the roles of altar server (youth or adult), reader, greeter, usher, and Eucharistic Minister. Our Lady of Light also holds monthly “Children’s Masses” at which the children are involved with these various liturgical ministries. Contact the Office for more information.

- **Program expectations**

Children preparing for the celebration of sacraments this year:

- Must be attending Mass weekly
- Must also be registered in the Parish
- Must have actively participated in a Faith Formation program last year
- Must actively participate in a Faith Formation program this year
- May not miss more than two Footsteps in Faith sessions per year
- May not miss any sacramental preparation sessions

The presence of one or both parents or a grandparent, preferably Catholic, is necessary at each session of sacramental preparation. The reason for this is that we include time where you are the teacher of your child for many of our sessions. The program we use is called “Growing Up Catholic” at growingupcatholic.com/Parent-home.html.

Preparation Components

Sacramental preparations may also include learning sessions, tours, videos, all-family events, outside projects, community service, “home” work, and liturgies.

Registration

July 31st is the deadline to submit registration forms for Sacramental Preparation. A late fee of \$10 will apply after July 31st.

Your child’s Baptismal Certificate should be attached to your Sacramental Preparation Registration Form.

Fee for First Reconciliation & Communion together: \$35.00
